Resolution

1. As per the recommendation of Academic audit report made by Bankura University our college website must be dynamic, informative and regularly updated. To make it successful it is resolved that one staff will act as WEBMASTER of the website and will provide necessary input regularly.
2. Model answer, for previous year University question to be prepared and these are to be kept in library for the benefit of the students.
3. Initiative for coaching classes for competitive examination to be taken care. Targeted students may be 5th and 6th SEM students of the college.
4. Energy, environment and green audit of the College for the session to be done. For this purpose, audit team of SKBU, Purulia may be contacted.
5. Necessary arrangement for E-waste management in the college to be started. College has to maintain a damage register.
6. More ICT enabled classroom are required for the college. Room No 141 to be upgraded as ICT enabled classroom specially for Mathematics Department. Two more ICT enabled Classrooms are required for Humanities Department.
7. As per recommendation of Environmental audit 'Vermi Compost' & 'NADEEM' to be developed with the help of Bio-Department.
8. College has to prepare a clear Budget Plan for the coming financial year. Internal audit for the financial year 20-21 and 21-22 has to be done.
9. New instruments for CIF to be purchased for upgrading research infrastructure and promoting research environment.
10. IQAC expect more activities like regular class, extension activities and cleaning and awareness programme from NSS.
11. Dr. N.R. Malas, Ex-IQAC coordinator proposed that IQAC Coordinator should be invited to the GB meeting when the agenda related to the IQAC will be discussed. All members supported this proposal.
12. IQAC recommends for furnishing a strong flexible and useful academic calendar for the coming session.
13. More skill enhancement courses to be introduced.
14. Steps to be taken to buy e-books and e-journal in the library.
15. No Fuel Day in the college campus to be observed on 12th and 25th day in every month.
16. High speed internet connection (100 MBPS) is required in IQAC and other places.
17. Funds to be allocated for teachers for attending seminar/workshop/symposiums. Registration fees may be disbursed from college through proper screening.
18. Initiative have to be taken for Institutional membership of British Council, Kolkata.
